Registration

Registration fee is \$60 - \$ 75.00 per camper **ONCE A YEAR** for all Lazy Acres camps. All fees are non-refundable.

Payments and Procedures:

Payments for each week of our Day Camp Program are due no later than the 1st day of each session (Monday). A \$10.00 late fee will be charged to your child's account if the payment has not been received by Tuesday AM. If we have not received a payment by Wednesday AM, your child **will not be permitted to attend camp. Once payment is made your child is welcome to return to camp!**

All Items must be labeled

We will attempt to return all labeled items. A lost and found basket is near the sign in desk, please check there at least once a week for lost items. If items are not claimed by August 30, 2007 the remaining items will be donated to a charitable organization or cause.

Snacks

Campers bring their own PREPARED lunch. We **CAN NOT** microwave items for campers. A lunch (PB&J sandwich, chips, cookie, fruit and a drink) will be provided to children that forget their lunch for a \$5.00 fee. An invoice reflecting any fees you are charged will be sent home with your child. The payments are due upon receipt. Lazy Acres will provide a morning and mid afternoon snack. These snacks are included in your weekly camp fee. Your child is also welcome to bring their on snack.

Towels for Water Activities

Each camper is required to have a towel for water activities every day. If a camper does not have a towel one will be provided for them at a charge of \$3.00 per day. An invoice reflecting any fees you are charged will be sent home with your child. The payments are due upon receipt.

Staff:

Our counselor to camper ratio = 10 campers to 1 counselor, Our staff takes pride in having the honor to be with your child. We will do our best to assure your child has an exciting, safe and fun learning experience at our camp. Along with several hours of training **ALL** our counselors are First Aide and CPR certified.

Kids Day Camp Disciplinary and Reward Plan

Lazy Acres is a Christian based day camp. We believe in the golden rule "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you". We encourage kindness and fairness towards others. Every child is entitled to a pleasurable and safe environment while participating in our program.

The following list is the type of behaviors that we expect all children to follow.

- o Respect for all children and staff
- o Be responsible for personal belongings
- o Participation in all activities that parent/guardian deems able
- o Possess positive and caring attitude
- o Follow proper safety procedures at special activities

Disciplinary Plan

Lazy Acres cannot serve children who display unacceptable behavior. If a child exhibits any type of behavior, which is thought to be unacceptable by a counselor and/or the Director, they will be warned to correct their behavior and a telephone call will be made to their parent or guardian.

A child receiving two warnings in one day will be suspended from specified activities for the next day in attendance. If their behavior is exceptionally disruptive, they may be suspended from Lazy Acres for the remainder of the session. A disciplinary notice describing your child's behavior will be sent home with your child to be signed by parent and returned to Lazy Acres. Refunds are not given when participants are suspended for unacceptable behavior.

<p><u>Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foul Language• Disrespect for another child or counselor• Fighting• Not participating in activities parent/guardian deems able• Ignoring or disobeying rules of safety• Public displays of affection• Defacing property/vandalism- automatic dismissal for 2 days• Stealing• "Name" calling• Hitting another camper, counselor or staff member – see 3rd incident	<p><u>Disciplinary procedure:</u></p> <p>1st incident – Parent notified by phone and/or writing</p> <p>2nd incident – Parent notified by phone and/or writing Child will not be allowed to participate in camp activities designated by staff</p> <p>3rd incident - Parent notified by phone and/or writing The action taken is at the discretion of Director after discussing situation with parent. Discipline may include child being dismissed for the day and/or a few from camp w/o refund for session.</p>
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Reward Plan

We reward good behavior and being kind to others with Lazy Acres Bucks. Every day a camper attends they receive 10 Lazy Acres Bucks. If the camper follows all the rules and is respectful to all campers and counselors they can keep their bucks. Campers that do not follow the rules or are disrespectful to other campers/counselors will lose bucks. Campers can also lose bucks for not bringing required items (water bottle, tennis shoes, swim suit, towel, etc) Counselors will determine how many bucks the camper loses. The camper will be told they have lost bucks. Campers can also receive extra Lazy Acres bucks for being chosen Camper of the Day, acts of kindness, being helpful to others. Lazy Acres Bucks are spent on Fridays. Bucks can purchase candy, toys, or a variety of other items.
